

#### About us

Centre for People's Forestry (CPF) works towards enhancing livelihood security of the marginalised sections among the forest dwellers/dependent communities. The National Forest Policy of 1988 insisted on sustainable management of forest with the participation of communities and NGOs. Whilst the government officials, both at national and state levels, were trying to translate the policy pronouncements to field realities, there was a need to build capacities of the communities to realise the benefits foreseen in the policy. This necessitated the establishment of an organisation to coordinate various stakeholders involved in forestry. Thus, CPF was established in 2002. In this context, CPF has been a platform for regular interaction among communities, NGOs, government officials and other stakeholders to debate and arrive at meaningful reflections/decisions on issues those need adequate attention.
